PROGRAMME FOR THE SALVATION OF BULGARIA

I. THE ECONOMY

403 Our political organisations are for the development of a **socially oriented market economy** with a limited amount of government regulation. This main goal we shall achieve through:

AGRICULTURE

405 1. Speeding up and completion in short terms the restitution of agricultural land, taking strong measures against those who create obstacles or try to slow down the process.

4011 2. Giving land to the people involved in agricultural production who do not possess any of their own, using the available municipal land for this purpose.

703 3. Providing low-interest credits for the private agricultural producers through special banks with the participation of the state and the international financial institutions.

703 4. Protection for the agricultural producers from unloyal foreign competition. Stimulation of exports.

703 5. Shortening the way of agricultural products from producers to consumers, removing the monopoly power of intermediary organisations. An effective purchasing system for agricultural output, supported and controlled by the state.

4015 6. Restitution of forests, provided that they will be preserved according to environmental requirements.

INDUSTRY, TRADE, SERVICES, BANKING

410 1. Restructuring of production in agreement with the demand of the internal market, the international markets and the participation of our country in the European and world economic structures.

408 2. Freedom of economic initiative for the state-owned enterprises combined with property responsibility of the members of their governing bodies for the results of their management.

410 3. Economic and legislative measures for the stimulation of home production.

407 4. National and regional programmes to attract foreign investment.

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5. Finishing the process of restitution. ✓

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6. Reform in the banking system through restructuring and gradual privatisation. Bringing in financial capital from famous foreign banks. Deposit guarantees and providing of low-interest credits for small and medium businesses through special government funds. ✓

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7. Strict financial control over the operations of the Bulgarian state-owned companies abroad and the joint ventures in industry or commerce. ✓

ENERGETICS

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1. Limiting monopoly power in the energy sector and exercising of strict financial and technological control in this sphere. ✓

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2. Support for the poor groups of society through payment transfers from the state for the electricity and heat they consume. ✓

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3. Promotion of energy saving and the utilisation of new energy sources. ✓

TRANSPORT

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1. Restructuring of transport in accordance with the general market principles for the development of the country, taking into account regional development, environmental protection, defence, safety and the established international connections. Preserving the control and ownership of the state over the strategic transport facilities and providing subsidies for passenger services of the railways, public city transport and transport to the remote regions and settlements. ✓

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2. Giving a priority to the construction of the transport corridors North-South and East-West in order to stimulate trade with the neighbouring countries as well as with the European Union. ✓

PRIVATISATION

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1. Gradual privatisation of the state-owned enterprises through:

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* selling of state property to Bulgarian and foreign persons who have legally acquired their capital. ✓

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* priority free selling to the broad public of moderate shares of stocks by the state aimed at creating a large number of small and middle holders. ✓

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* distribution of privatisation bonds with a certain value to all adult Bulgarian citizens according to the length of their employment and other priorities as a compensation for the national capital they have created during the period of the communist dictatorship. ✓

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* compensation by privatisation bonds for all the expropriated or destroyed by the communist authorities property which cannot be restituted in real terms. ✓

414 * creation of a market for the privatised property accompanied by control over the origin of capital; ✓

411 2. Proceeding with privatisation through a system of laws and regulations including a requirement for preservation of jobs, openness and maximum information for society. ✓

413 3. Preservation of state ownership over economic structures of strategic interest. ✓

I. ECONOMY

Our political organizations are in favour of the development of a
403 SOCIALLY ORIENTED MARKET ECONOMY with limited state
403 regulation. We aim to achieve this central purpose by means of :
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AGRICULTURE

1. Speeding-up and completion within the immediate future of the
4015 restitution of agricultural lands while taking severe measures upon
4015 those who slow or hinder the process.
2. Provision of land from the available municipality land for all
504 landless agricultural proprietors.

- 703 3. Provision of low-interest credits for private agricultural proprietors,
 703 by means of a specialized bank, with the participation of the state
 408 and the international financial institutions.
 406 4. Protection of the Bulgarian agricultural producers from unfair
 408 foreign competition. Efforts to stimulate exports.
 403 5. Curtailing of the distance of agricultural produce from the
 403 producer to the consumer, through the elimination of the monopoly
 and profiteering of the intermediate buying-to-sell organizations.
 412 The creation of an effective system for the buying of agricultural
 412 produce, that will be supported and controlled by the state.
 4015 6. Restitution of the forests, and the provision of adequate control of
 501 their utilization in accordance with ecological requirements.

INDUSTRY. TRADE. SERVICES. BANKING.

 408 3. Measures to encourage the saving of energy, and the exploitation
 of new sources of energy.

TRANSPORT

- 411 1. Restructuring of transport in accordance with the general market
 411 principles of development of the country, while bearing in mind the
 501 need for regional development, preservation of the environment,
 1041 national defense, safety and the preservation of established ties with
 411 foreign partners. Measures to maintain control, and ensure
 412 continued state ownership of strategic transport networks, and to
 413 provide subsidies for passenger transport in the railway system, in
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- 411 the city transport systems, and for transport to far-out regions, towns

PRIVATIZATION

 - handing-out of privatization coupons with a fixed value to all
 4014 Bulgarian citizens of full legal age, in accordance with their length of
 701 service during their work years and with other priorities, thus
 providing compensation for the national capital that they have
 2053 accumulated over the years of the communist dictatorship;
 4014 - compensation by means of privatization coupons, for all forcefully
 2053 confiscated or destroyed by the communist regime production or
 non-production property which cannot be restituted in their initial
 2053 shape and form;
 403 - creation of a market for privatized property, coupled with tax
 605 control of the origin of capital.
 4011 2. Privatization by means of a system of laws, which should include a
 504 requirement for the preservation of jobs, at complete openness and
 202 maximum information made available to the public.
 413 3. Preservation of state ownership of economic structures which are
 of strategic importance to the country.

II. TACKLING CRIME

 304 Ministry of Internal Affairs and from the legal system;
 304 - crimes committed by state employees;

- crimes relating to the unlawful transformation of state into private property; 304
- racketeering, sale and distribution of narcotic substances, physical aggression against the elderly and against children, spreading of pseudoreligious ideas, which endanger the psychic and physical health and life of the citizens; 605, 603, 603
- acts of aggression against the police, inquest, prosecution and the courts, and disobedience of their orders; 605, 605
- 5. Provision of private protection only on the basis of labour contracts entered upon by the respective owners or their associations; 605
- 6. Introduction of a strict measures relating to the ownership of weapons by citizens. Upon violation, responsibility will be sought not only from the owners of such weapons but also from their suppliers; 605

III. SOCIAL POLICY

- 1. Provision of stable sources of income for the Pension Fund, in view of the purpose of its gradual independence from the state budget; 504
