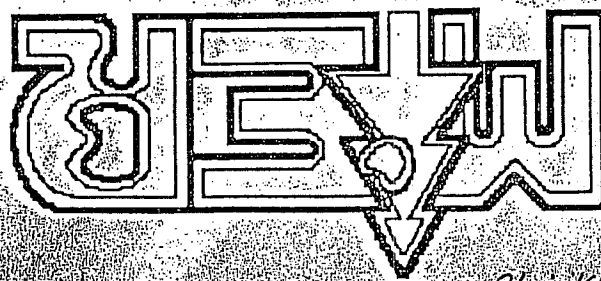

THE PROGRAM OF THE ECOLOGICAL MOVEMENT OF ROMANIA

The Ecological Movement of Romania (EMR) is a large current of public opinion and social action that is independent, democratic and antiauthoritarian, pacifist and humanitarian, non-violent and intolerant only towards intolerance. It embodies the yearning of the Romanians for life governed by Truth, Goodness and Beauty, in ecological terms. EMR's political thought is derived from the scientific background of social life and consists in shaping the Romanian society based on the vital accord between human beings and the environment, between culture and civilization. As this century has proved, neglecting nature in the relationship of culture and civilization is extremely dangerous for the future of humanity and for life on this planet. Subscribing to all the rights of man ratified by the UNO chart, EMR also strives for the right of nature to permanently protect the human being, even in spite of the latter's will. Consequently, EMR's opinion is that pollution of the environment means pollution of human life, of human society. Therefore, fighting against pollution in nature is fighting against pollution in human life and society, against political, social, economic, moral and cultural pollution. Therefore, in an ecological outlook, EMR groups its intentions in a system of aims that can be summed up as it follows:

1. POLITICAL AIMS

201 To observe human rights, that are indefensible and inseparable from human personality, from its possibilities of accomplishment;
 201 To lay the foundations of a sane political life, of an open dialogue (based on reason). To give free way to human intelligence, to competition among initiatives and logical arguments, to latent human energy;
 202 To strengthen democracy in all the branches of State activity; to put an end to cheating, demagoguery and hypocrisy;
 304 To make State policy be founded on justice;
 303 To make good measure regain its place in political thought and action.

 407 -To attract foreign capital in mutually advantageous investments, considering real and long-term needs of the economy; to create a system of laws that protect the national interest in my; to develop a varied range of small-scale industrial activities, workshops that would meet the needs of towns and villages;
 409 -To ecologize trade: the quality of goods should be controlled/prices should be cut for perishable goods;
 412 -To create Popular and Federal Department Banks for granting credits for tourism, agriculture, small-scale industry and trade activities.
